1. Purpose of this Expression of Interest

The Global Pulse Confederation (GPC) is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified and independent organisations to provide independent management services of the GPC Pulse Atlas & Pricing Report.

This EOI is the first stage of a two-stage process. Organisations that complete this EOI and satisfy the mandatory eligibility criteria set out below will be invited to submit a full proposal in response to a Request for Proposal (RFP), which will set out the scope of work, submission instructions, timeline and pricing requirements in full.

2. Background

The Pulse Atlas & Pricing Report is GPC's digital database that provides international market data, trends and forecasts for the global pulse sector, covering a defined set of commodity groups and origin/destination markets. The Report provides weekly market intelligence and price comparisons across major pulse crops and global destinations.

As part of an ongoing strengthening of the governance and independence of its price reporting process, GPC is seeking to engage one or more independent parties to take on some or all of: data collection and coordination; independent review, validation and verification; market assessment and reporting; and the supporting governance, compliance and technology functions that is consistent with recognised good practice for price reporting agencies (PRAs) and applicable competition law.

GPC may award one contract covering the full scope described below, or separate contracts for discrete elements of that scope, at its sole discretion.

3. Indicative Scope

The services in scope, to be set out in full in the RFP, are expected to include some or all of the following:

- Data collection and coordination, including administration of the network of price-submitting contributors.
- Independent vetting and validation of submitted prices for bias, outliers and conflicts of interest.
- Market assessment and reporting, including weekly and monthly price reports and market commentary.
- Governance and compliance, including a documented and published methodology, anti-manipulation controls and a full audit trail.
- Technology and delivery of the data collection systems, publication platform and data security arrangements.

4. Eligibility — Mandatory Independence and Conflict of Interest Declaration

Compliance with the EOI declaration is a mandatory, pass/fail requirement in order to progress to the second stage. Every respondent must complete and sign the declaration below before being considered eligible to proceed to the RFP stage.

The undersigned certifies that:

- The organisation is not engaged, directly or indirectly, in the trading of pulses, grains, oilseeds or related agricultural commodities; the brokerage of pulse transactions; or the ownership or control of trading operations within the pulse sector.
- The organisation does not have any financial interest that could reasonably influence the outcome of published price assessments.
- The organisation has no actual, potential or perceived conflict of interest that may compromise independent market reporting.
- Any existing commercial relationships with pulse processors, exporters, importers, traders, brokers or industry associations have been disclosed in full (attach details separately if needed).
- The organisation agrees to notify GPC immediately should a conflict of interest arise at any point during the tender process or the term of any resulting contract.

5. How to Respond

- A one-page summary of your organisation, relevant experience and the scope element(s) above you wish to be considered for.

This EOI is an invitation to participate and does not constitute an offer or a commitment by GPC to award a contract. GPC reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to amend, suspend or withdraw this process at any time, and to accept or reject any expression of interest without providing reasons.

6. Next Steps

Organisations that meet the mandatory independence criteria will be invited to submit a full technical and pricing proposal in response to the RFP. GPC anticipates issuing the RFP to eligible respondents shortly after the EOI closing date; indicative timing will be confirmed at that stage.
